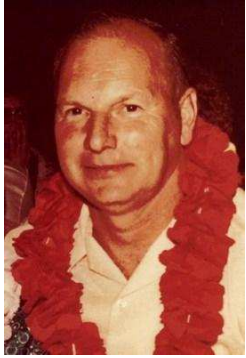

Arthur Leroy Adams
